COMMUNITY PROFILE

The Quabbin Regional School District is located near the geographical center of Massachusetts, just a short drive east of the Quabbin Reservoir. A rural, regional district, Quabbin is composed of five member communities, Barre, Hardwick, Hubbardston, New Braintree and Oakham, with a combined population of nearly 15,000, dispersed over an area of 165 square miles.

We are served by four K-5 elementary schools, and a grade 6 - 12 Middle-High school. Students who reside in Oakham and New Braintree attend school in Oakham for grades K - 5. Tuition free Pre-K classes are held in Barre, Hardwick, Hubbardston and New Braintree. The New Braintree Grade School supports our Post Graduate program as well as preschool for students from New Braintree, Oakham, and other district towns.

As one of the most sought after school choice schools in the Commonwealth, we enroll over 250 school choice students from 17 surrounding communities. Our total enrollment this school year is 2,200.

Quabbin's motto, "Be Quabbin", illustrates the pride we feel in our schools, evidenced by our rigorous academic offerings and by numerous pathways for students interested in furthering their education either in a college environment or finding success in a career or military environment. Quabbin offers AP classes and International Baccalaureate classes with the opportunity to receive an IB diploma. Dual enrollment and internships are offered in collaboration with community partners. Quabbin features a wide range of programming as evidenced by our high achieving NJROTC, STEM, art, music and athletic programs.
