The Waltham School Committee is seeking an individual to serve for as the interim superintendent of schools for a period starting on August 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025. The specific length of this interim superintendency is to ensure the completion, successful opening, and smooth transition to the new Waltham High School currently under construction. A search for the permanent superintendent to assume the leadership of the district in July 2025 will begin in the Fall of 2024. The interim superintendent will be permitted to apply for the permanent position.

The interim superintendent should have experience working in a district like Waltham (5,500 students) which is suburban but with many urban facets. The successful candidate should have experience with career and technical education, dual language programs, and issues common to a diverse student and family population.

A competitive salary and benefit package will be provided subject to successful negotiation of a mutually agreeable contract of employment. As noted, the successful interim superintendent will be permitted to seek the permanent position.
