COMMUNITY PROFILE

The community of Norwood is a residential suburb of about 29,000, located fourteen miles west of Boston, near major highways and rail lines. It is located within anhour's drive of Cape Cod and the north and south shore beaches, and less than two hours to the recreational mountains of New Hampshire, Vermont and western Massachusetts.



Boston's renowned cultural, educational and medical resources are within a half-hour commute. With the commercial/industrial areas located near the major highways, Norwood's downtown appears as a quaint New England village "center" with its central park surrounded by a variety of stores, boutiques, churches, a renovated, historic theatre and a distinctive, statuesque town hall. Norwood has outstanding police, fire, recreation, public works and other municipal services. It is a well-governed, well-managed town that prides itself on being a vital community, and an exceptional environment in which to raise children.

The Norwood Public Schools have a fine reputation for providing quality educational programs for students at all levels. The town passed its first operational override in a resounding support of the schools to prevent drastic cuts and bolster curriculum and services. The district is in the midst of several strategic improvement efforts: New Middle School Building in progress set to open for the 2025/26 school year with grade 5 moving up and out of elementary buildings, Kicking off Elementary School Study this year to assess space and programming with middle school shift, completed equity audit 2022, recently aligned curriculum efforts across the district...among other things. The comprehensive fine arts program and renowned music program, as well as the student activities and athletic programs are very extensive and enjoy heavy student participation. Norwood also belongs to The Educational Collaborative (TEC), a premier 15-town, multi-function education collaborative and is a member town in the Blue Hills Regional Vocational Technical School district.

Norwood is also the home of a fully staffed recreational center; a variety of athletic facilities; an active Senior Center; indoor and outdoor community concerts; a very popular performing arts center; a full range of restaurants and hotels; a fine public library; and numerous fraternal, social and civic organizations.

Like many Boston area towns, Norwood is steeped in rich historical traditions. Settled in 1678 and for years part of Dedham, Norwood separated as its own town in 1872. From its earliest days as a farming community, through its 19th century development as a mixed agricultural-industrial community, to its present day status as an exceptionally attractive residential community with a vibrant and diversified high-tech/commercial sector.
