- Possess excellent communication skills and be a leader in community engagement and involvement

## Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Licensed as a Superintendent of Schools in Massachusetts
- Master's degree required, Ph.D. or Ed.D. preferred
- Minimum of 10 years in education, including 3 years in administrative and/or central office experience and 5 years of teaching experience preferred
