

- Positive communication and public relations informs the community of the activities and needs of the school system.
- Strong business and financial management skills.
- The ability to promote a positive, supportive learning environment that includes high expectations for all students and staff.
- The ability to maintain a cooperative and productive work relationship with the school committee, staff, students, parents, town governments, and the community.
- The ability to support a visible, participatory management style.
- Support creative management strategies to develop and administer a budget that reflects the resources of the towns in Southern Berkshire and advances the goals of the school district.



QUALIFICATIONS

The Southern Berkshire Regional School Committee seeks a dynamic, energetic individual to assume the leadership of the district on an interim basis. The following qualifications are required:

- Licensed as a superintendent of schools in Massachusetts;
- Master's degree required, advanced degree preferred;
- Minimum of 15 years in public education, including 5 years central office or other administrative experience and 5 years teaching experience;
- Demonstrated knowledge of school finance and business management as a school administrator.
- Strong leadership, communications, and public relations skills.
- Experience in a regional school district desirable.


COMMUNITY PROFILE
